## Activities

### EDUCATION/AWARENESS ACTIVITIES

Since 2004 we have been supplying all 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders in Wakulla County with the educational "Kind News" publication, a newspaper for children teaching responsible treatment of animals and more. Teachers and students appreciate this so much. We plan to grow our educational program and need volunteers interested in this area.

### TNR PROGRAM FOR FERAL CATS (Trap-Spay/Neuter-Return)

Wakulla County's feral cat population is growing at an alarming rate. Paws is applying for grants to implement a Trap/Neuter/Return program, PawsTNR, to reduce the number of kittens born, reduce nuisance calls and intake at the Animal Shelter, and protecting other small wildlife in Wakulla County.

### PET MEALS ON WHEELS

Many seniors are lonely and their pet is their family and provides affection and unconditional love. Paws has partnered with the Wakulla County Senior Citizens Center to help provide pet food to home bound seniors' pets and individuals under hospice care. Many seniors share their meals with their pets due to not being able to purchase pet food. Our goal is for both the individual and pet to have proper nutrition.

### WORK WITH LOCAL RESCUES

Since we no longer manage the adoption center, we work with local rescue groups in many different ways. The challenges these rescues take on require many resources and support.

The mission of Paws of Wakulla, Inc. is to improve the health, safety and well-being of domestic and community cats and dogs and to the prevention of cruelty against animals in Wakulla County through education and community service. Paws of Wakulla is also committed to reducing the feral cat population in Wakulla County.

Paws monies are derived from membership dues, donations, fundraisers and grants, and are carefully managed and reviewed at each board meeting. Funds are used to purchase items such as:
